



Meetings online at CLIB

Over time, as in any organization, we have sought to optimize CLIB's internal procedures in order to generate operational gains in efficiency and functionality. This is the case of the meetings that now take place online, at more flexible times, where possible, Parents and Teachers meet from where they are, at times distributed throughout the day and more easily reconcilable.

The pressure of finding teachers available to meet after 4 pm (after school hours), when many still have CLIB Clubs to teach, or are returning to their homes, is no longer a limitation for scheduling meetings, and it is now possible to find other times throughout the day, in which it is possible to reconcile availabilities.

The classrooms and spaces inside the school are also made profitable for use by small groups of students, before and after 4 pm and CLIB Clubs that take place there after 4 pm, as well as the cleaning that is carried out by a company external to CLIB.

Life in society evolves and, naturally, we follow and learn from these changes. Without ever compromising communication and the means dedicated to it, quite the contrary, we welcome this possibility of being ever closer and more available.

Exceptionally, we understand that the September meetings (welcoming meetings) could be face-to-face, and invite Parents to come to CLIB and also meet the new families, at this time when we meet again for the beginning of another year, given that they are the only meetings that take place as a group. Other meetings regarding individual students will be online, as we never talk about a student in the presence of another parent.

There is a huge availability of everyone at CLIB to meet with parents and this is only possible if it takes place in an organized manner and at times agreed by both parties.
